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


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

V_{DS} - Drain-to-Source Voltage (V) **Output Characteristics**





I_D - Drain Current (A) On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage

V_{GS} - Gate-to-Source Voltage (V) **Transfer Characteristics**








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




Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage






On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient




Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient



Power, Junction-to-Ambient



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
