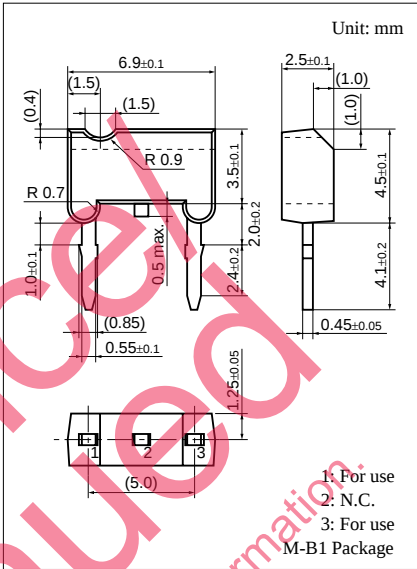
For overcurrent protection

- The package is molded with high dimensional accuracy.

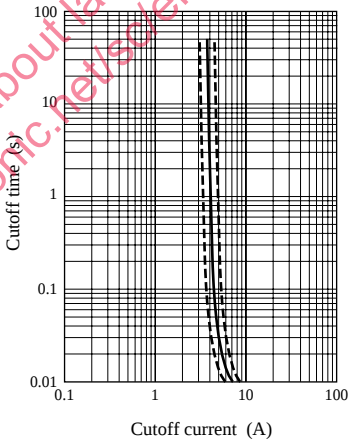
