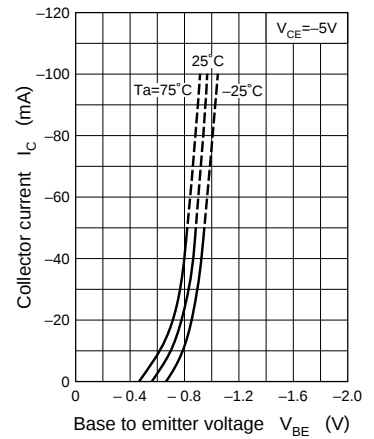

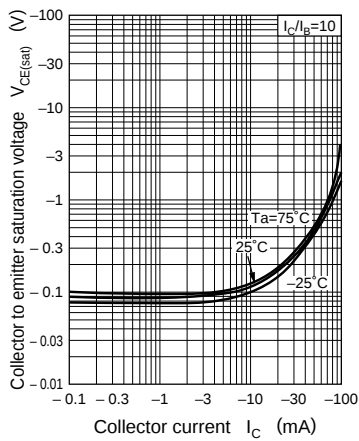
$I_C - V_{CE}$



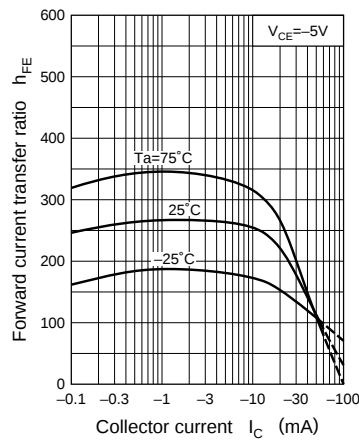
$I_C - V_{BE}$



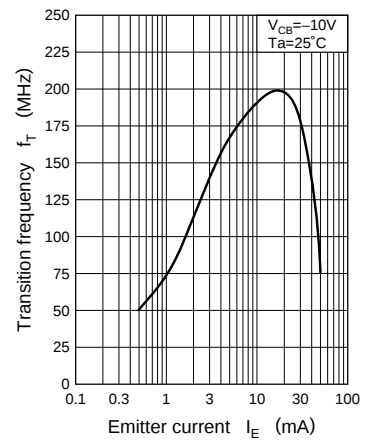
$V_{CE(sat)} - I_C$
