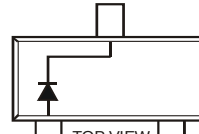

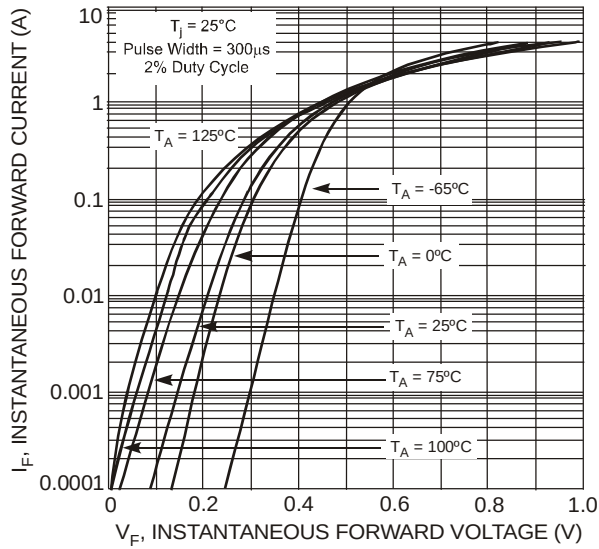


Fig. 1 Typical Forward Characteristics

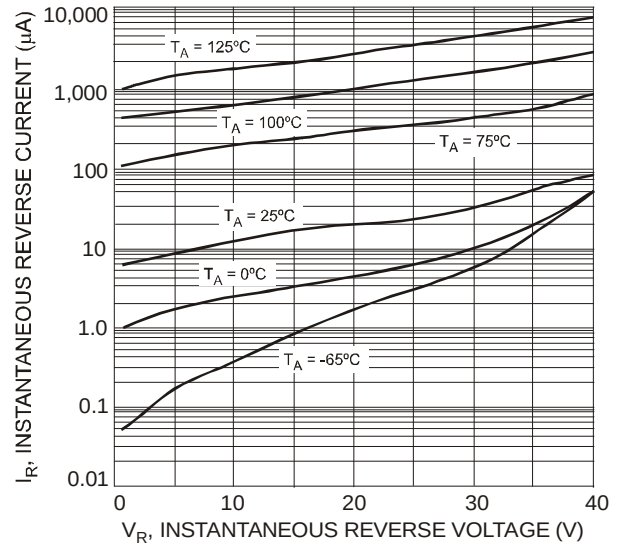


Fig. 2 Typical Reverse Characteristics

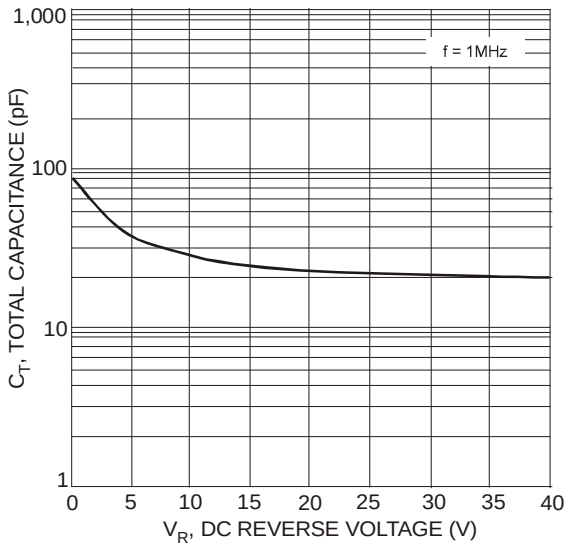


Fig. 3 Total Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage

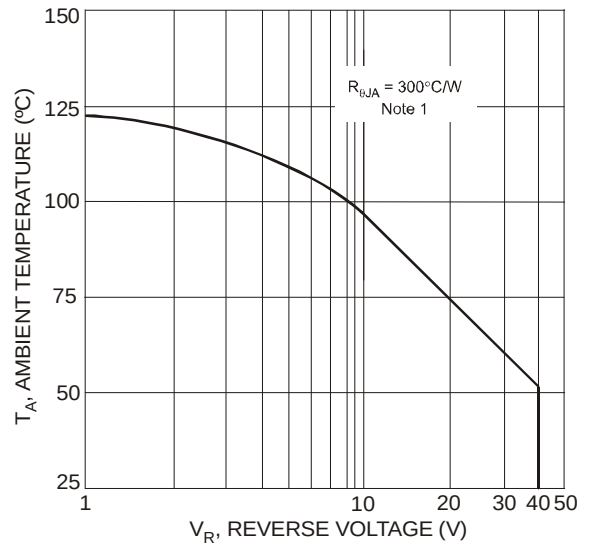


Fig. 4 Typical Safe Operating Area

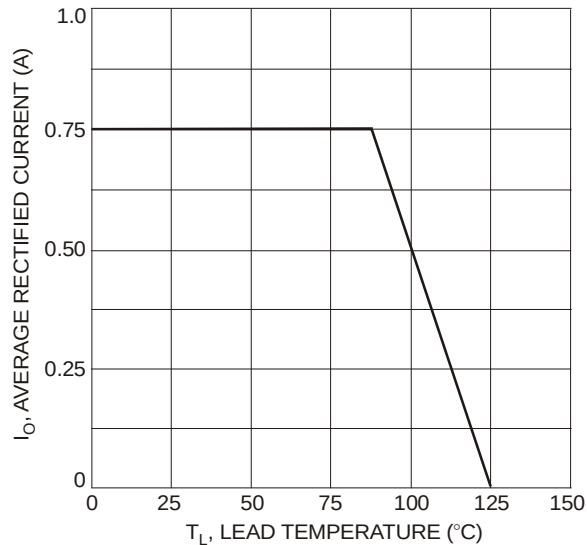
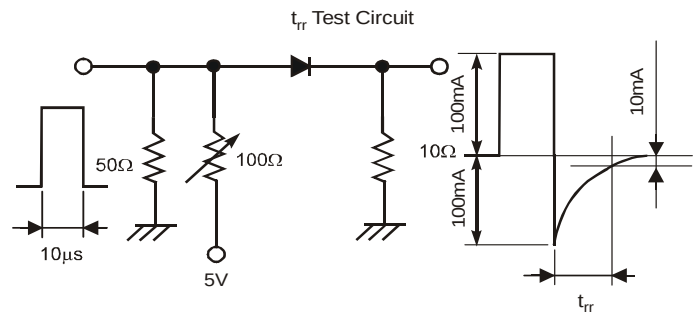


Fig. 5 Forward Current Derating Curve

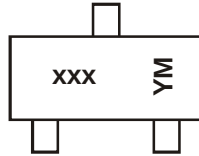

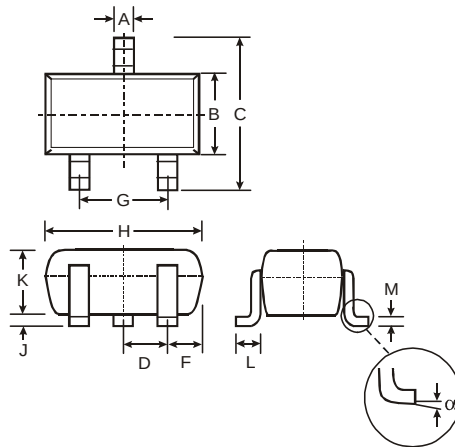

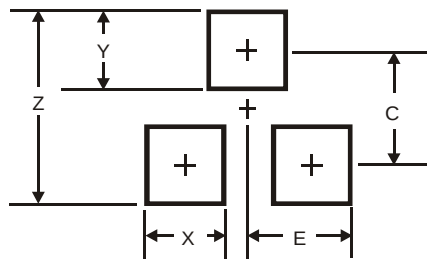
