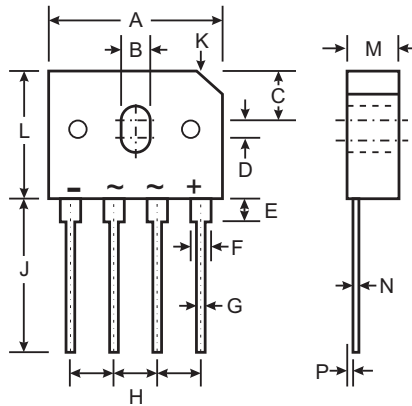

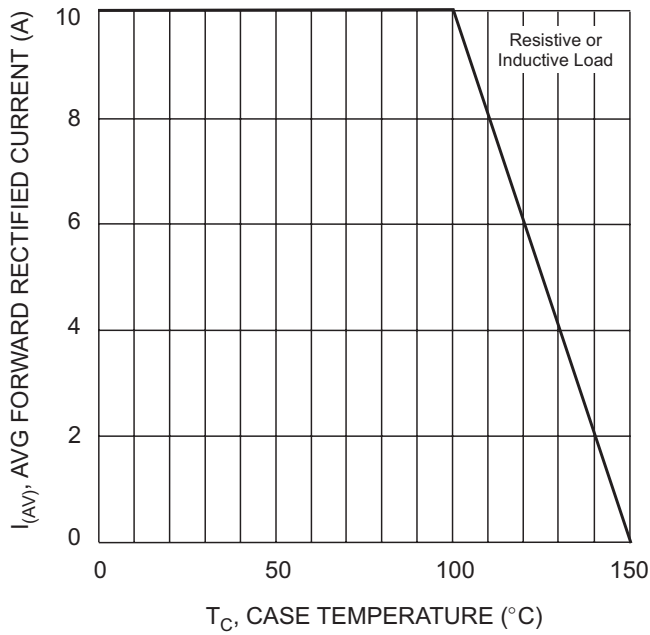


Fig. 1 Forward Current Derating Curve

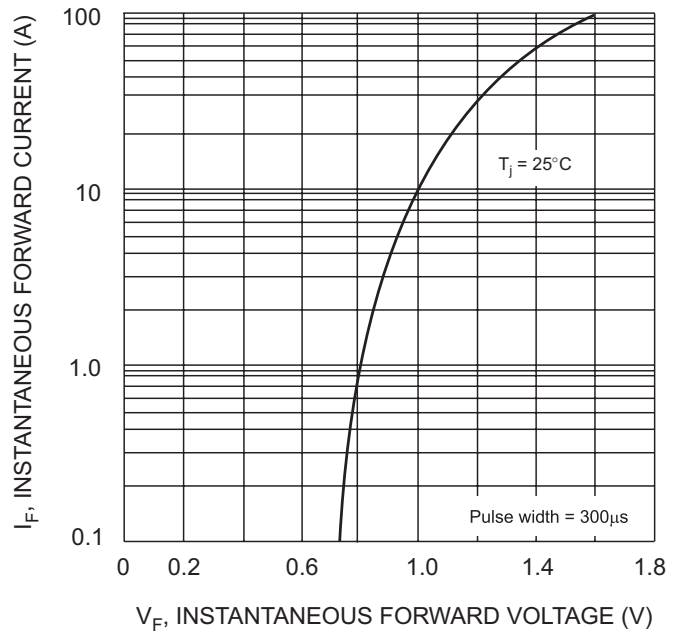


Fig. 2 Typical Forward Characteristics, per element

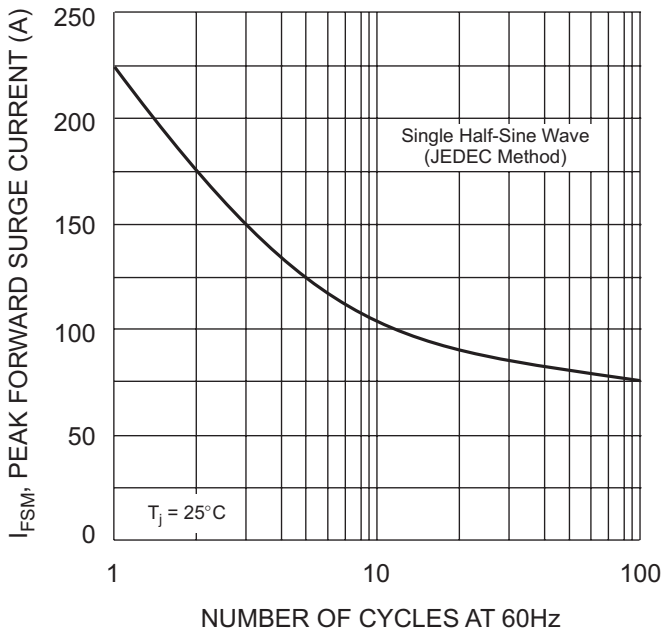


Fig. 3 Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current

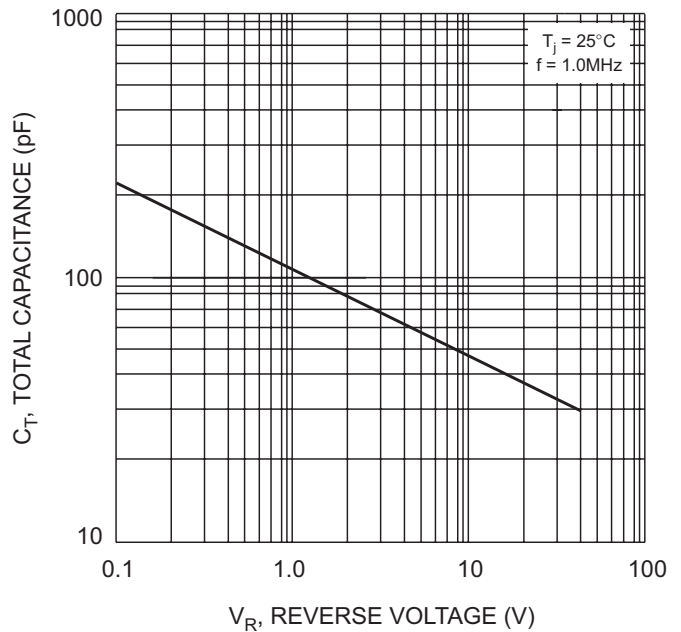


Fig. 4 Typical Total Capacitance, per element
