


Figure 1. Delay and Rise Time Test Circuit




Figure 2. Storage and Fall Time Test Circuit




Figure 3. DC Current Gain




Figure 4. Collector Saturation Region




Figure 5. Turn-On Time




Figure 6. Turn-Off Time




Figure 7. Frequency Effects




Figure 8. Source Resistance Effects




Figure 9. Capacitances




Figure 10. Current-Gain - Bandwidth Product




Figure 11. "On" Voltage




Figure 12. Temperature Coefficients

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



Figure 13. Safe Operating Area


