


Figure 1. Pinout (Top View)




Figure 3. Failure Rate versus Time Junction Temperature






Figure 4. Switching Waveform



Figure 6. T<sub>PZL</sub> or T<sub>PLZ</sub>




Figure 8. AC Output Enable and Disable Waveform
